- 5 Read the passage below and answer the questions that follow.

A mobile application also known as an app is a computer program or software application designed to run on a mobile device, tablet or smartwatch. Mobile applications stand in contrast to desktop applications which are designed to run on desktop computers. There are now millions of apps available and many of them require internet access. Apps are generally downloaded from app stores. The term 'app' was listed in 2010 as 'word of the year' by American Dialect Society. Mobile applications are generally classified into three: native apps, web-based apps and hybrid apps. All apps targeted toward a particular mobile platform are known as native apps. For example, an app intended for Apple device does not run on Android device. A web based app is implemented with the standard web technologies of HTML 5, CSS, and JavaScript. Internet access is typically required to use all features and the performance of such apps is similar to a web application running in a browser. Hybrid apps are a mixture of native and web-based apps. They are easier and faster to develop and involve use of single codebase which works in multiple mobile operating systems. A May 2012 comScore study reported that during the previous quarter more mobile subscribers used apps than browsed the web on their devices: 51.1% versus 49.8% respectively. Market research firm Gartner predicted that 102 billion apps would be downloaded in 2013 (91% of them free) which would generate \$26 billion in the US. By Q2 2015, the Google Play and Apple Stores alone generated \$5 billion and over 5,29,000 jobs were created in 28 EU states due to the growth of the app market.
